The FBI said in a statement issued by its Baltimore field office that an initial **examination** had found that the data had not been copied or misused in any way.

Decker’s chateau dates to about 1668 when **construction** started.

The plants would largely be built in factories, to cut costs and quality problems; legal questions would be settled before **construction** started, he said.

[...] For that reason and others, **construction** took time. But the house was eventually built according to the architects' -- and LEED's -- high standards.

It was King Faisal of Saudi Arabia who was first able to win approval for a mosque in Rome in 1973, at a time when Catholicism was still officially the state religion in Italy. The **construction** took 20 years and about \$ 50 million, of which 80 percent came from Saudi Arabia.

Glastonbury Abbey, the first church to be built in the British Isles (**construction** began in A.D. 63, legend has it) not only contains the grave sites of King Arthur and Queen Guinevere, but also, some assert, the remains of St. Patrick.

The museum has been designated a Smithsonian affiliate, and **construction** began last week.

But to date, the only nuclear plant being built in Europe is a Finnish reactor that was the focus of 12 years of debate before **construction** began last year.

The hullabaloo over the new airport is only the latest parable of India's growth. That tale begins with the government's decision to sign a deal with a private consortium to build the new airport, agreeing to close the old state-run one, and effectively giving the new one a monopoly. Generous as it was to the developers, it apparently failed to account for the Indian zeal to fly. Air traffic in and out of Bangalore has more than doubled since **construction** began three years ago, compelling the developer to amend the design of the airport.

The conceptualization process for California Adventure, which is smaller than the 75-acre Disneyland, began in 1995, and **construction** began three years ago.

According to Wolfgang Kahlke, a spokesman for the museum, the \$ 150 million project is to be completed in six to eight years after **construction** begins in 2000.

If you want to include plants and flowers in your upgraded patio or deck, think about your irrigation needs before **construction** begins.

Wyeth designed the mansion, and **construction** began in 1922.

Though Ellis did much of the design work and thousands of mathematical calculations necessary to build the bridge and developed the specifications and contract forms, Strauss fired him before **construction** began.

Designs for the path began much later, and **construction** began within the past year and a half, said Kathi R. Anderson, executive director of the project.

The new tunnel is expected to last between 60 and 75 years. Before **construction** begins in 2010, the state will need to spend \$ 2 million annually on maintenance to extend the tunnel's life.

"A new stadium in L.A. certainly is a priority," Aiello said. "We hope to help get it accomplished." If **construction** begins by September, the stadium would be ready for the 1997 season, Hollywood Park officials have said.

Taxpayers voted to lease the town building for \$ 1 a year, and voted to provide \$ 150,000 to fix up the building. Biedermann's group raised more than \$ 1.3 million, **construction** started in August 2001, and the museum opened last Aug. 16 with 12 exhibits, one borrowed from the New England Ski Museum.

#### ***installation***

##### **Definite Null Instantiation**

Kano was known as a REMOTE site and **installation** began in 1960. Kano provided UHF and HF relay with the Mercury spacecraft.

## ***evaluation***

### **Definite Null Instantiation**

### *translation*

#### **Indefinite Null Instantiation**

VR-Exchange has a graphical user interface (Portal application) that provides a view into the shared memory space. The Portal application does not control the translation process. **Translation** takes place in the brokers.

Even where **translations** took place, they were not available in accessible formats like in Unicode, Sign Language, Braille or talking books.

In the 1950s, building on excitement over the advent of digital computers, scientists foresaw machines that would instantly translate Russian to English. Rather than 5 years, machine **translation** took more than 50.

**Translations** took place in the 9th, 15th and 17th centuries, and the remains now rest beneath the altar in the chapel of Clement VIII.

When a non-English speaker goes to an emergency room or clinic, accurate **translation** can be as important as quick medical attention. (Gigaword)

Dix says the challenges she faced in Cuba not only put her research at Oberlin in perspective, but also enhanced her experience. In spite of the 18-hour days, the heat, and the exigency of constant **translation**, Dix says it was worth it.

This method helps you to avoid constant **translation** and instead allows you to think in French.

Data science demands learning a different style of thought: often divergent, poorly defined, and requiring constant **translation** in and out of the technical sphere.

So couldn't this process, which happens internally, almost be said to be one of 'constant **translation**', perhaps even more so than these intertextual traces above already suggest?

If you need an exact translation (and you really do if the translation involves your business or a marriage proposal), consider a commercial service where the **translation** is done by humans, not a computer. (Gigaword)

### **Definite Null Instantiation**

Although the Bible has been translated into almost every language, this English version remains the most influential of all. Timewise, the actual **translation** took three years, as did the review.

Though his translation of the Greek New Testament was originally a solo effort, completed in a few weeks, in translating the Old Testament, Luther was aided by Philip Melanchthon and others at the University of Wittenberg, and the **translation** took twelve years to complete.

Translating a book will be different from translating what a speaker is saying. The book is finished and is in fact required to be finished if successful **translation** is to occur. The structure of expectation must be complete before **translation** begins.

Thus, programs written in a high-level language have to be translated before they can run. This **translation** takes some time, which is a small disadvantage of high-level languages.

DAVID: So, in this context, with millions apparently reaching toward their faith with more intensity, you are giving us this new contemporary translation of the Christian New Testament. TOM: Yes, but I should point out that this **translation** took me 10 years.

22-23 June – Italian Tech Week (Online): At the invitation of the Turin Chamber of Commerce Women in Business Committee, Che Miller Van Dÿck, DLI Founding Director, participated in an online fireside chat with Carla Bertuzzi on the subject of “digital skills for girls.” The **discussion** took place in the context of several activities promoting Girls in STEM and women-led entrepreneurship as part of Italian Tech Week on 22 and 23 June.

The performance was followed by a discussion of what we can do, individually and collectively, to end the violence. Structured **discussion** continued in a time of small group conversation but dialogue and connections were happening all day – in the hallways, at lunch, during the love feast in the closing worship and even after the event ended.

It is a pity that the **degradation** has reached such a stage that taxpayers are obliged to meet a bill of \$ 8 billion.

But Nasami at last gives the organization space for large-scale **propagation** of otherwise unavailable plants, especially native trees and shrubs such as the upright-growing smoke tree and the green-trunked moosewood.

Or, as the novelist Katherine Anne Porter sees it, “our style is an **emanation** from your own being.”
