“20th International Morphology Meeting” (September 1–4, 2022; Budapest, Hungary)

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Linguistic Field(s): Morphology; Word Formation; Linguistic Theory

Meeting Description:

As the next event in the (by now) long series of Morphology Meetings in Central Europe, the 20th International Morphology Meeting will be held in Budapest, Hungary, between 1 and 4 September, 2022, organised by the Hungarian Research Centre for Linguistics. The meeting will serve as an event commemorating the late Prof. Ferenc Kiefer, one of the ‘founding fathers’ of the IMM series, who passed away in December 2020. The meeting will consist of a main session, a poster session, and four workshops.
